## WGA GENERAL RULES OF GOLF ETIQUETTE

**Slow play is a problem. Do not wait in carts until each player hits. Play ready golf (the first person to their ball hits).**

**Keep up with the group ahead of you.** If they get out of sight, you should either speed up your play or let the group behind you play through.

Take a practice swing, not multiple swings, before it is your turn to hit the ball: then go directly to your ball.

Do not leave your bag or cart in front of the green. Drive around to the side or back.

Please rake bunkers and repair ball marks on the green. Do not replace divots, but do fill them with sand (provided on your carts).

Do not stand in front of or behind another player's line. Stand still and do not walk around or talk while others are hitting or putting.

Look over your putt while others are putting. Be ready when it is your turn.

Do not walk through another player's putting line on the green.

Do not let your shadow fall upon another player's putting line.

Do not be a no-show. If you cannot make your tee time, please call and cancel prior to Wednesday.

Any member of your group who has already putted out should be ready to replace the flag in the cup as soon as the last person has finished putting.

When you cannot ride on the course, take several clubs with you so you don't waste time returning to the cart for another club.

When close to the green, take your clubs and putter with you and go directly to the green instead of returning to the cart to get your putter.

Remember, when you have finished playing golf and are returning home in your cart, players on the course have the priority. You must not drive your cart on the path when they are in the process of hitting a shot or putting. Wait to move your cart when they are moving in your direction.
