

Rod & Gun Club - Archery/3D Range Rules

1. The archery range will be open only to SLV Rod and Gun Club members except for special events approved by the SLV Rod and Gun Club board.
2. There will be no consumption of alcoholic beverages or illegal drugs on the archery range at any time. No person shall be permitted in the archery range area while under the influence of drugs or alcohol.
3. Arrows will be released only in the direction of downrange targets using the provided backstops.
4. All bows pulled to full-draw must be aimed downrange toward appropriate target.
5. All archers must keep fingers away from quick release until the arrow is aimed downrange at an appropriate target and the archer is ready to release.
6. Multiple archers (two or more) may not release arrows at a single target at the same time.
7. An arrow may not be nocked or bow pulled to full-draw while another archer is downrange removing an arrow or arrows from a target.
8. Make sure that all persons around you are aware of your whereabouts when you are searching for arrows.
9. Never shoot an arrow off into the distance where you cannot see where it will land. Never shoot straight up.
10. On the 3D range, be sure to stay on the marked path and travel only in the direction in which the targets are laid out while shooting is in progress. Going into an unmarked area could place you in the path of a flying arrow, resulting in serious injury or death.
11. No broadheads at any time in any butt targets or 3D targets. Field points only. Bow hunters needing to practice with broadheads are required to provide their own cube or broadhead targets.
12. All trash or litter will be removed from the archery range when the archer departs the range. Any property damage caused by the archer will be his or her responsibility.
13. All gates must remain closed and locked at all times. After entering the range area, close and lock the gate.
14. Please park in designated area only.
