MISSION

The McCormick County Farmers' Market serves as a market place that supports the growth of our local and sustainable agricultural businesses and a healthy life style in the McCormick County communities by encouraging the consumption of locally grown fresh food.

DESCRIPTION

The McCormick County Farmers' Market operates in late-spring and throughout the summer. The main season starts on May 31st. The Dorn Mill Cotton Gin serves as the location of the McCormick County Farmers' Market. No business licenses are required by growers to sell their produce at the Market. Preference is given to growers from McCormick County and its vicinities. Fees and regulations are established by the McCormick County Farmers' Market Planning Committee.

MANAGEMENT

The McCormick County Farmers' Market is managed by a Planning Committee composed of the following organizations and public bodies: the Town of McCormick, McCormick County, Clemson Extension, the McCormick Chamber of Commerce, the McCormick Historical Commission, the MACK, the Savannah Lakes Village, the McCormick Garden Club, the McCormick County Master Gardeners and the John de la Howe School. The Dorn Mill Complex Commissioners serve as the Market Managers and are responsible for the daily operations. Any fees collected from growers and other vendors go to the Dorn Mill Complex to cover expenses related to the Farmers' Market.
